



PhD, Post Doctorates, Academic Staff:

How to write a research / academic proposal for the application (and for the prospective supervisor)?

Each PhD and Post Doc, who applies for a grant within IAMONET-RU **must** include a research proposal within the application.

Your research plan should include the following topics / information in the correct order:

1. First name, Surname, Home University, Current Activity
2. Name of the research / activity project
3. Background and Objectives
4. Methods and Materials
5. Relevance
6. Expected results
7. Expected cooperation
8. Further implementation of the results of training at the Host University
9. Time Schedule (leading activity)
10. Publications
11. Additional information, which is needed: Name of the professors which were contacted already, confirmation from the supervisor (yes / no)

Please write the proposal as a body text. The length of the plan should be the maximum of 3 pages (font size 12, Times New Roman, Spacing 1,5).

The plan should be written in English or in the language of the host university.

Please enclose your research plan to your application package for IAMONET-RU
