Programme: Erasmus Mundus Partnerships (Action 2)

- EM Partnerships is a cooperation and mobility scheme in the area of higher education between the European Union and Third Countries including scholarships for mobility at all academic levels
- launched by Europe Aid Cooperation Office and implemented by the Executive Agency Education, Audiovisual and Culture (EACEA)

Objectives of the Project IAMONET - RU

Implementation of a sustainable International Academic Mobility Network between EU and Russian higher education institutions in the fields of Life Sciences, Agriculture and Food Chain covering a wide range of scientific disciplines in order to:

- integrate leading Russian universities into the European Area of Higher Education
- contribute to the development of BSc, MSc and PhD programmes according to the Bologna requirements at Russian universities
- apply a common system of recognition of studies according to ECTS and encourage the development of joint and double degree programs between EU and Russian universities
- enhance the qualification of teaching staff and younger researchers and to facilitate the transfer of knowledge

Project Actions

- Scientific education and training of students on BSc, MSc and PhD level
- Joint research activities in the fields of Life Sciences, Agriculture, and Food Chain
- Training and retraining of scientific staff and development of updated teaching materials
- Further reform of current Russian study programmes according to the Bologna recommendations
- Transfer of know-how related to the introduction of ECTS from EU to Russian universities
- Further development of quality assurance systems according to international standards
